Triumphing over Fears and Foes through Confidence in Yahweh

 - c. His singular desire for Yahweh (v. 4)

 - d. His expected benefits of Yahweh's house (vv. 5-6)

- II. David's Petition: "O Yahweh, be my refuge!" (vv. 7-12)
 - a. Please hear me (vv. 7-9)

 - b. Please teach me (vv. 10-12)

- III. David's Exhortation: "Make Yahweh your refuge." (vv. 13-14)
 - a. His final assurance of confidence (v. 13)

 - b. His parting exhortation to action (v. 14)
